Termination of contract: The owner/agent of the dog(s) may withdraw the dog at anytime during the activities; however, **all fees are non-refundable**.

LIABILITY

I _____ as the legal owner/agent of the above mentioned pet(s), having carefully read and fully understanding this agreement, do hereby waive and release Doggie Central and its affiliates from any and all liability of any nature. This includes any injury; death, sickness or damage my pet may suffer during or resulting from these activities. It is understood that dogs are in a community and while Doggie Central and affiliates take reasonable safety precautions, dogs can contract common ailments such as, but not limited to ear, eye and skin infections, nicks and scrapes. I also agree to indemnify and hold harmless Doggie Central, from any and all claims due to damage the pet may cause to any family members or any third parties during or resulting from training or exposure to other dogs.

• I certify that my dog is in good health, and agree to follow these rules as outlined below:

- Dogs in heat will not be allowed on the dock or on premise. If a dog is found to be in heat, it is the responsibility of the handler to immediately remove the dog from the swimming area and disinfect all areas where the dog was present.
- Should the dog appear to be injured or ill, the dog's handler will be asked to cease activities until such time as the dog regains health. Examples of injury shall include visible limping, bandages, stitches, and open wounds (a "hot spot" is not considered an open wound).
- Should the dog be known to have had a recent injury or be exhibiting bandage wraps, a letter from an accredited veterinarian, on appropriate letterhead, must be presented to the pool activity coordinator no less that thirty (30) minutes prior to any activities, stating that the dog is healthy and able to swim.

• **Control and Containment:**

- All dogs must be crated or held by the handler or an assistant of the handler on a six (6) foot lead at all times while on site. Dogs must remain within their crating area at all times when not swimming unless pre-approved permission has been granted by the Doggie Central staff.
- Owners and handlers must control their dogs at all times. Aggressive, dangerous or highly disruptive dogs will be required to leave the premises, no fees or purchases will be refunded.

• **Collars, Leashes & Vests:**

- Collars: Only flat buckle collars may be worn on the dock
- Choke collars, prong collars or electronic collars, gentle leaders, halti-collars, or any other collar other than flat buckle-type collar, are not allowed. Any collars of this nature must be removed prior to swimming.
- Leashes are required.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash that is six (6) feet long or SHORTER at all times while on Doggie Central grounds. All other leads, including retractable (i.e. Flexi Leads), are strictly prohibited in all areas.
- Dog vests and personal flotation devices are permitted.

• **Leash Rules:**

- During dock diving events and practices, no dog shall be allowed off-leash in any part of the practice area, including the exercise area, except for on the dock or in the water itself. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE. At no time during practice, swimming or other events shall more than one dog be off leash at the same time. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.
- During open swim sessions, dogs enrolled in the swim sessions may be off leash when in the pool area, however, dogs must enter and exit pool areas on a leash.

• **Children:**

- Not all dogs like or tolerate children. For this reason, Doggie Central or its affiliates does not permit children under the age of 7 years old to be in our pool or warehouse areas. Any child 7 years or older, must be supervised at all times.
- No strollers or joggers are allowed. Anyone who brings a child under the age of 7 will not be allowed to participate in pool or dock jumping activities and must leave the premises. No fees or purchases will be refunded.

• **Media Ownership:**

- Photographs or video are often taken of dogs at Doggie Central and/or dogs enrolled in any of Doggie Central's programs. I hereby release such media as the sole property of Doggie Central and give Doggie Central permission to use any such material for training, advertising or other promotional purposes.

In the event that Doggie Central deems it necessary to employ legal counsel to protect their rights under this agreement, the owner/agent of the dog(s) agrees to pay all expenses incurred by Doggie Central to enforce their rights under this agreement including, but not limited to, costs and reasonable attorney's fees.

This agreement represents the full and only agreement between parties. I have read, and fully understand, and agree to the above contract terms.

• **Cancellation or No Show for Swim Appointments:**

- Client will be billed 100% of the total charge of their scheduled swimming appointment if client doesn't call to cancel within 24 hours. (Except for emergencies and sudden illness with a letter from your Vet.)
